# Program Overview

PGCA Homeschool Offers:

- Comprehensive umbrella oversight program approved by the Maryland Board of Education.

## **On-site Classes:**

The On-Site Program offers in-person and hybrid classes Monday through Thursday for students who prefer live instruction from experienced tutors. Classes include English, math, science, history, Bible, and electives. Students also have access to select online classes through Imagine Learning LLC, options include full-day classes or à la carte choices. Our structured programs create a college preparatory environment that promotes time management, study skill development, and academic diligence.

Juniors and seniors benefit from the option of concurrent enrollment. It allows students to take courses through a local community college and earn both college and high school credit. Typically, students can take their college courses online or on campus. Since most colleges allow you to transfer credits between colleges, students in dual enrollment programs can apply the credit they earn toward a degree at many colleges while also satisfying their high school graduation requirements. Check with your specific college.

## **On-site Student Orientation:**

New students attend a 3-day orientation in August to meet staff, learn policies and procedures, and navigate the onsite schedule.

## **Athletics:**

PGCA provides a national-level athletics program that allows student-athletes to compete at the highest level of high school sports. Our athletics program is based on three main principles: skill development, competition, and exposure. We prioritize developing the physical, mental, and emotional well-being of student-athletes at all times.

- The academic program offers flexibility and rigor to create a unique student-athlete experience that fosters academic and athletic success.
- Extra academic support, as needed, from our Academic Advisor and tutors
- Daily athletic skills training, strength and conditioning, and practice opportunities built around the school day
- Our mental toughness coach and FBCG youth pastor support coaching the whole person and promoting Christian values.

## **Parent Training:**

This program includes monthly updates for parents, virtual meetings to assess students' learning, and guidance on the basics of homeschooling. This focused assistance can help parents develop a successful homeschooling experience. Additionally, one-on-one meetings with parents are available to discuss the resources needed for the school year, and guidance is provided throughout the process.
